



**Amendment No. 3 to
the Telecommunications Master Service Agreement
Contract Number: 178AN-TISA2018-0820**

WHEREAS CenturyLink Communications, LLC (“CenturyLink”) and MiCTA desire to modify the terms of Contract No.178AN-TISA2018-0820 Telecommunications Master Service Agreement (the “Agreement”) in the manner set forth in this Amendment No. 3 and its attachment(s) (the “Amendment”). The Amendment shall be effective as of May 20, 2020 (the “Effective Date”).

NOW, THEREFORE, CenturyLink and MiCTA agree to modify the Agreement as follows:

1. Modification of the Terms and Conditions of the Agreement. The Parties hereby agree to add *the Smart Solutions Portfolio for Venue, City, Community, Campuses, and Buildings* (the “Smart Solutions Portfolio”) to the Seller’s MICTA Program Officer in Attachment A of the Agreement. The Smart Solutions Portfolio shall provide Access Controls, as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto for illustrative purposes, and as agreed to by the Parties.

1. Seller’s MICTA Program Pricing. The Program Pricing in Attachment B of the Agreement is modified to accommodate the tasks/deliverables for the Smart Solutions Portfolio which will be provided via a scope of work (“SOW”) priced on an individual case basis (“ICB”) depending on the specifics of the engagement.

3. Conflicts, Use of Terms, Headings. In the event of conflict between the terms and conditions of the Agreement and the terms and conditions of this Amendment, the terms and conditions of this Amendment will control. Where applicable, the defined terms in the Agreement shall have the same meaning in this Amendment.

4. No Other Modifications. Except as provided above, the terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged.

Smart Solutions Portfolio for Venue, City, Community, Campuses, and Buildings

Access Controls

Task / Deliverables	Description - Labor for Access Control Installation, Engineering, and Project Management
Task 1 - Access Control Panel Services	The CenturyLink team will provide services to cutover the current access control panels to new Mercury Boards deployed in New Enclosures including new door lock power supplies.
Task 2 - Card Reader Services	The CenturyLink team will replace X Card Readers and Supplier will add X Card Readers for a Total of X Card Readers.
Task 3 - Door Contact and Rex Device Services	The CenturyLink team will replace X door contacts
Task 3 - Door Contact and Rex Device Services	The CenturyLink team will install X Rex Devices
Task 4 - Door Strike Services	The CenturyLink team will cut in and install X new door strikes
Task 5 - Glass Break and Panic Button Services	The CenturyLink team will cutover X existing Glass Breaks and X existing panic buttons to the Access Control System.
Task 6 - Software Services	The CenturyLink team will deploy the Access Control software and associated licenses on the server, add controllers, and program doors on the Access Control Software
Task 7 - Client Workstation Services	The CenturyLink team will set up X client workstations, deploy the web license, and set up Badge templates.
Task 8 - Testing Services	The CenturyLink team will test all doors and functions of the system as part of completing the project.
Task 9 - End Customer Training	The CenturyLink team will provide training to the end customer on how to properly use the Access Control system, doors, and functions.
